EYEWEAR CLEANING 101

IS YOUR CLEANING TECHNIQUE DOING MORE DAMAGE THAN GOOD? FOLLOW THESE TIPS TO KEEP YOUR GLASSES CLEAN AND CLEAR.

FRAMES FIRST!



Wipe away facial oil on the temples, bridge and nose pads, this will help avoid smears when cleaning the lenses.

DON'T GIVE A SPIT



Using your breath or spit as a quick fix is tempting. But it's not effective and certainly not hygienic.



LENSES LOVE LIQUID

Use lens cleaner or dish soap with warm water, ensure you avoid citrus-based soaps. Dry with a clean microfiber cloth.



KEEP YOUR CLOTHES TO YOURSELF

Using your shirt, a tissue, or paper towel seems innocent enough, but they contain dust and other particles that can scratch lenses.



DITCH THE VINEGAR, WINDOW CLEANER, AND TOOTHPASTE

Stronger chemical cleaners, especially ammonia, can damage lenses and lens coatings.



DO IT DAILY!

Make a habit of cleaning your glasses every day, it will help you avoid the tempting but harmful quick fixes above.
